


Greek philosopher, Hippocrates discovered that there are four kinds of people in the world. The Flag Page explains the four people as Hippocrates did in his writings. To keep it simple, we use the 4 Country analogies. Just as different countries have various languages, beliefs, customs and values, so do people who come from the land of Control, Perfect, Peace and Fun country. These people are very different.

Our 4 Country Map gives you the first glimpse into what is right about you when you're at your best. Each of the 56 traits you voted for describes people from one of the 4 countries. The country you voted for most heavily is where you feel comfortable. We call it your "Home Country". The country that received your second highest number of votes is called your "Adopted Country". Your Adopted Country has a big influence in how you live in your Home Country. For example; Peter's Home Country is Control and his Adopted Country is Perfect. Because of this combination, he finds a big need to get things done and get them done right. On the other hand, if Peter's Adopted Country was Fun instead, there is a great change. Now Peter needs to get things done, but he wants to have fun doing it. Take notice of your Home and Adopted Country combination.
