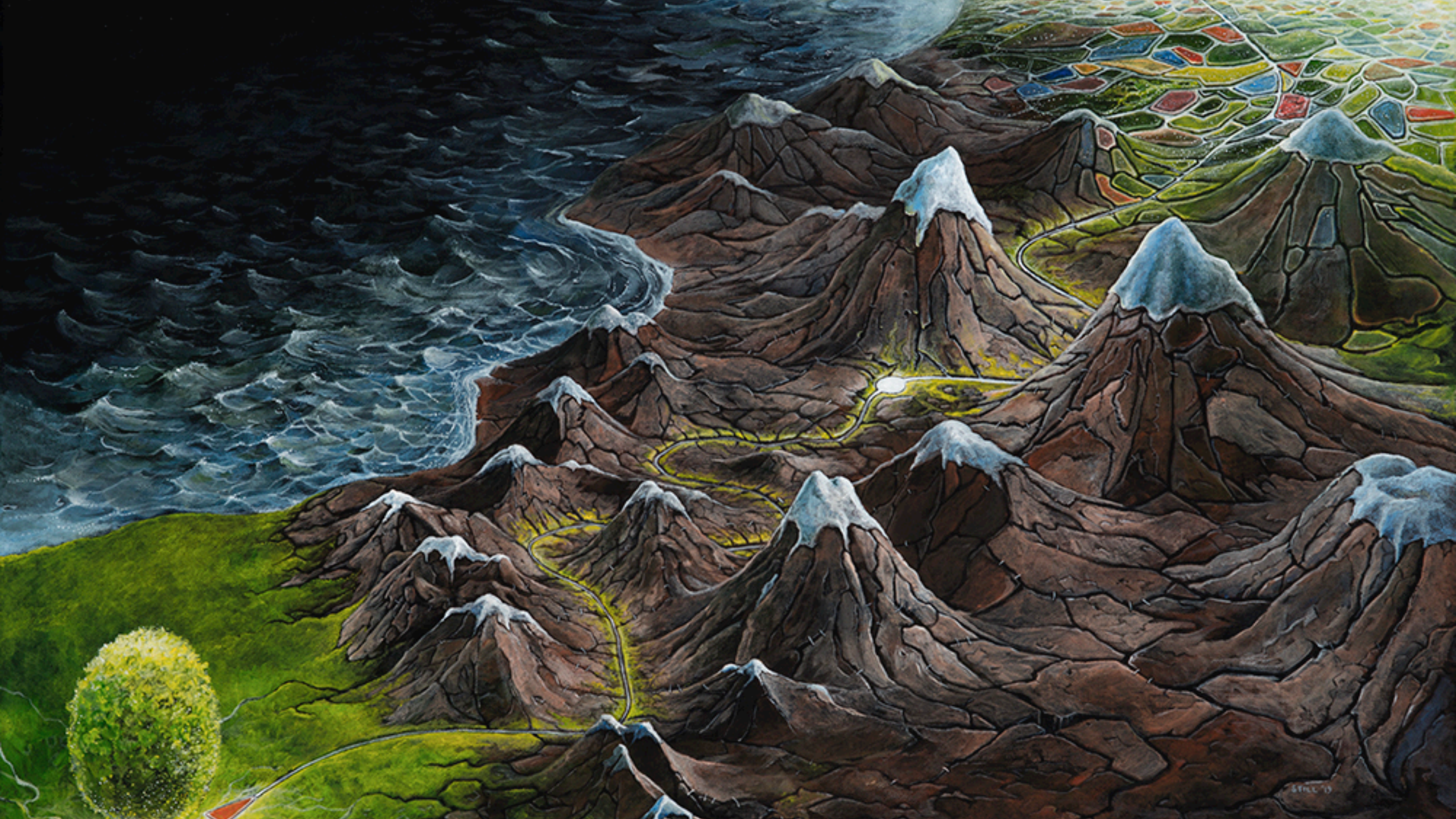


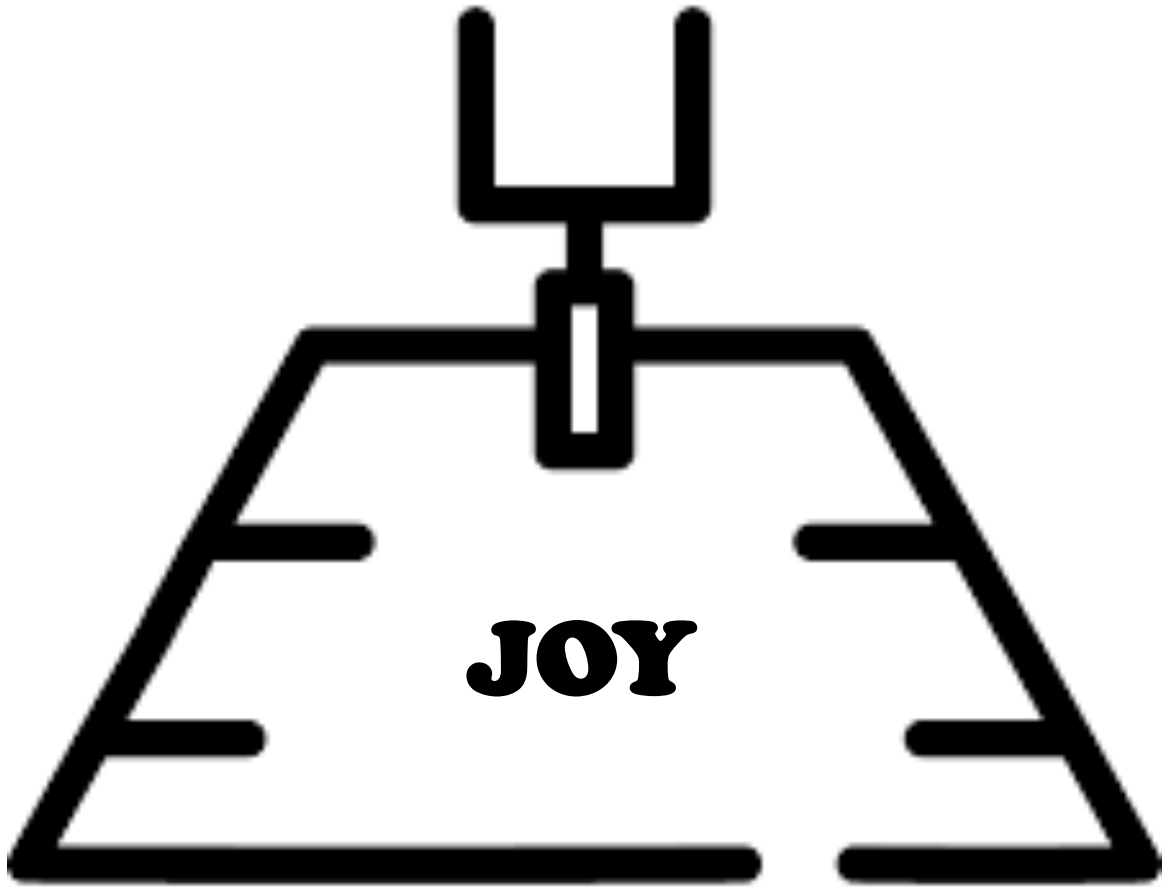

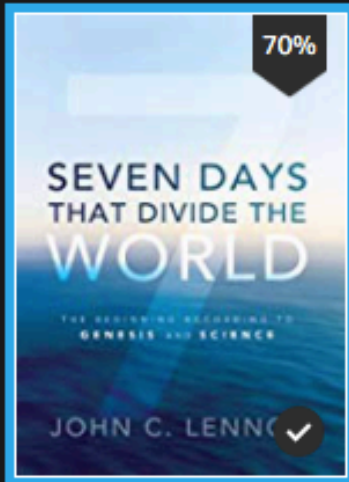


Faith & Reason = Friends

Like “Why do we exist?”

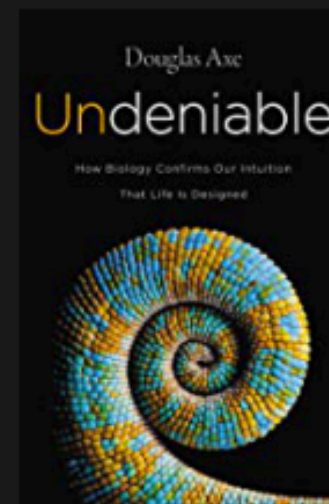
All *supposed* conflicts between Scripture and Science are the result of either a flawed approach to Scripture or a flawed approach to Science



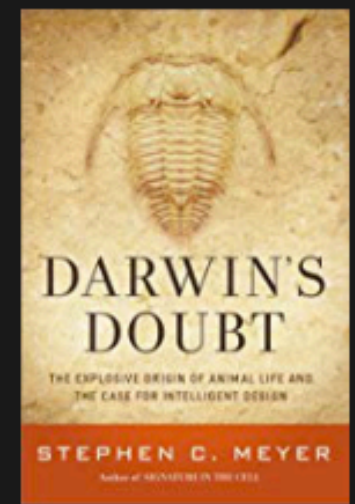
