Mushy Truth



The truth matters.

It directly impacts what we believe, value, and do. In other words, it affects how and what we live our lives for.

The Main Idea:

Paul wants to reorient their expectations regarding the coming resurrection by focusing on the nature of the resurrected body to come.

Primary Argument:

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the promise of our resurrection from the dead and Christ's total victory over sin and death. The empty tomb is full of power.

³⁹ Not all flesh is the same flesh; there is one flesh for humans, another for animals, another for birds, and another for fish. ⁴⁰ There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the splendor of the heavenly **bodies is different from that of the earthly** ones. ⁴¹ There is a splendor of the sun, another of the moon, and another of the stars; in fact, one star differs from another star in splendor. (CSB)

⁴² So it is with the resurrection of the dead: Sown in corruption, raised in incorruption; ⁴³ sown in dishonor, raised in glory; sown in weakness, raised in power; ⁴⁴ sown a natural body, raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. (CSB)

⁴⁵ So it is written, The first man Adam became a living being;[,] the last Adam became a life-giving spirit. ⁴⁶ However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, then the spiritual. ⁴⁷ The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven. ⁴⁸ Like the man of dust, so are those who are of the dust; like the man of heaven, so are those who are of heaven. ⁴⁹ And just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we will also bear the image of the man of heaven. (CSB)
