False teachers arose and led people astray




John wrote to counter the false teaching and comfort the faithful remnant of the church

Truth as the Father's commands:

I rejoiced greatly to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as we were commanded by the Father. And now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it. (2 John 4-6)



Truth as Christ's teachings:

Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house or give him any greeting, for whoever greets him takes part in his wicked works. (2 John 9-11)



Loving in and because of the truth:

The elder to the elect lady and her children, whom I <u>love in truth</u>, and not only I, but also all who know the truth, <u>because of the truth</u> that abides in us and will be with us forever: Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ the Father's Son, in truth and love. Loving in and because of the truth:

And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments... (2 John 6)

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. (1 John 5:2-3)
